



The new NPrinting engine is multi-threaded, and supports clustering, allowing a number of engines to run in parallel, improving scalability and reliability for large volume deployments. Role-based security allows administrators to control and manage access to development and reporting features at a granular level, and a new web-based user interface supports multi-developer environments.

With QlikView NPrinting, QlikView can serve as a single solution for both interactive analytics and reporting. The same QlikView data models can be used for both purposes, allowing organizations to retire legacy BI systems and save significant costs. And, organizations can include links to live QlikView apps in report distributions, encouraging passive consumers to adopt interactive analytics to explore their data further.
